

Privacy Policy

What this privacy policy covers

In accordance with the Data Protection Act, this policy gives you information about how Going for Independence treats personal information received from our web site visitors.

What is personal information?

Personal information is defined as information about you that is personally identifiable such as your title, name, address, email address and phone number.

The only time we'll use your details for any other purpose than those listed above is to email you from time to time about our services. However we will only do so if you have given us permission to do so, having opted in on one of the data collection forms.

We respect your privacy and will not rent, sell or share personal information about you with other people or non-affiliated companies.

Information collection and use

Cookies

The Going for Independence site uses cookies to collect information about how the site is used by its visitors. Cookies provide non-personal statistical information about visits to pages on the site, which may include the duration of individual page views, paths taken by visitors through the site, and other general information. None of this information is associated with you as an individual.
